



BIAS BOUCLE SCARF (knit)

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Size: Approx. 4" x 60"

Materials:

130 yds. light worsted wt. novelty wool/poly boucle (sample shown in Laines du Nord "Opaline")

Size 15 needles

Tapestry needle to weave in ends

Gauge: 16 sts = 4" in garter stitch on size 15 needles

Stitches/Terms: bind off (BO), cast on (CO), decrease (dec), garter stitch (knit every row), knit (K), increase (inc), purl (P), right side (RS), stitch (st), stockinette stitch (st st), wrong side (WS)

Notes: Count stitches every row to be sure to maintain 16 stitches.

Mark right side (front side) of scarf with contrast yarn or clip-on marker (or remember that when the yarn tail from the cast-on row is hanging to your right, you are working on the right side (front side) of the scarf.)

Increase (inc) by knitting into front and back of same stitch (Kf&b)

Decrease (dec) by knitting 2 together (K2tog)

SCARF

Cast on 16 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Increase in first stitch (by knitting into front and back of first stitch), knit across to last 2 sts, decrease (by knitting last 2 sts together) (16 sts)

Row 2 (WS): Knit across, without increasing or decreasing (16 sts)

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until scarf measures *approx. 60", or until yarn is almost gone, reserving enough for bind off row.

Bind off loosely and weave in ends.

If necessary, lightly block scarf between damp towels.

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
