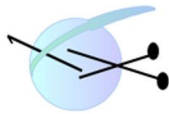

## CHECKER-STRIPE SCARF (knit)

Size: Approx. 4-1/4" x 50"

### Materials:

120 yds. lightweight fluffy merino wool, or other fluffy DK-wt. yarn  
(sample shown in Crystal Palace "Merino Frappe")

60 yds. ea. of 2 colors eyelash yarn (Color A and Color B)(sample  
shown in SRK The Collection "Fizz")

Size 15 needles

Yarn needle for weaving in ends

Gauge: 3 sts = 1" in garter stitch with 2 strands yarn on size 15  
needles

Stitches/Terms: beginning (beg), bind off (BO), cast on (CO), garter  
stitch (knit every row), knit (K), stitch (st)

NOTES: To keep your sanity when working with these yarns, place  
each ball of eyelash in its own zipper-top sandwich bag,

letting strand of yarn feed from bag. Move bags from side to side to  
keep from tangling yarns at color changes. Work with 1

strand wool held together with 1 strand eyelash throughout scarf,  
dropping strand of eyelash to change colors as instructed. Do

NOT cut yarns, but leave them hanging until needed again. When  
changing colors, be sure to bring new color up from under old

color, dropping old color over top of new color.

### Scarf

With 1 strand wool held together with 1 strand eyelash (in Color A), cast on 14 sts. Knit 7 rows.

#### Begin checkerboard pattern:

Row 1: With Color A, knit 7, drop Color A, attach Color B, knit 7.

Row 2: With Color B, knit 7, with Color A, knit 7.

Row 3: With Color A, knit 7, with Color B, knit 7.

Row 4: With Color B, knit 7, with Color A, knit 7.

Row 5: With Color A, knit 7, with Color B, knit 7.

Row 6: With Color B, knit 7, with Color A, knit 7.

Row 7: With Color A, knit 7, with Color B, knit 7.

Row 8: With Color B, knit 7, with Color A, knit 7.

#### Reverse checkerboard pattern:

Row 9: With Color A, knit across row (leave Color B hanging in middle of row).

Row 10: With Color A, knit 7, with Color B, knit 7.

Row 11: With Color B, knit 7, with Color A, knit 7.

Row 12: With Color A, knit 7, with Color B, knit 7.

Row 13: With Color B, knit 7, with Color A, knit 7.

Row 14: With Color A, knit 7, with Color B, knit 7.

Row 15: With Color B, knit 7, with Color A, knit 7.

Row 16: With Color A, knit 7, with Color B, knit 7.

#### Reverse checkerboard pattern:

Row 17: With Color B, knit across row (leaving Color A hanging in middle of row).

Repeat Rows 2-17 twice.

#### Begin stripe pattern:

Row 1: With Color B, knit across, picking up Color A strand and weaving it in across row to move Color A to side of piece. Do

NOT cut colors, but carry strands loosely up side until needed again.

Rows 2-4: With Color B, knit across.  
Rows 5-8: With Color A, knit across.

Continue to work 4 rows Color B followed by 4 rows Color A, until yarn is almost gone. Bind off and weave in ends. Shake scarf

gently to fluff eyelash.

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
