

SILK TWEED LACE SCARF & MINI BAG (knit)

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Skill level: Intermediate

Size: Scarf: Approx. 3-1/4" x 58"

Bag: Approx. 4" x 3"

Materials:

118 yds. light worsted or DK-wt. silk/cotton blend tweedy-nub yarn (sample shown in Rowan "Summer Tweed")

Size 11 needles (for scarf)

Size 8 needles (for bag)

Size G crochet hook (for bag)

Button (for bag)

Gauge:

In lace pattern, 14 sts = 3-1/4 " on size 11 needles

4 sts = 1" in garter stitch on size 8 needles

Stitches/Terms: bind off (BO), cast on (CO), chain (ch), knit (K), knit two together (K2tog), purl (P), slip slip knit (ssk), slip stitch (sl st), yarn over (yo)

Scarf

NOTE: Before beginning scarf, reserve about 50 yds. of yarn for mini bag.

With size 11 needles, cast on 14 sts.

Knit 2 rows.

Begin pattern:

Row 1: K1, K2tog, yo, K1, yo, ssk, K2, K2tog, yo, K1, yo, ssk, K1.

Row 2: Knit across (14 sts)

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until yarn is almost gone, reserving enough for last row and bind-off row.

Last row: Knit across.

Bind off, cut yarn and weave in ends.

Mini Bag

With size 8 needles, cast on 16 sts. Work in garter stitch (knit every row) for 56 rows, or until piece measures 8".

Begin flap:

Row 1: K2tog, knit across to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Continue to decrease 1 st at beg and end of ea row until 3 sts remain.

K3 tog, place remaining loop on crochet hook.

Button loop: With crochet hook, ch 7, sl st back into base of chain, fasten off and weave in ends.

Bag assembly: Fold cast-on row of bag up to 1" below where flap decreases begin. With tapestry needle and length of yarn, whipstitch sides of bag tog. Weave in ends.

Chain strap:

With crochet hook, attach yarn to one side of bag where flap folds over front. Ch 100, attach to other side of bag opposite beg of chain strap. Fasten off and secure ends.

Finishing: Fold flap over front of bag to find placement of button. Sew on button and fasten button loop over it.

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
