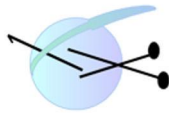

FIFTEEN-FIFTEEN NOVELTY FRINGED SCARF (knit)

Size: Approx. 6" wide x 72" long

Materials:

180 yds. novelty thick & thin knobby yarn (sample shown in Filatura di Crosa "Dali" - S. Charles Collezione "Sabrina" is a suitable substitute)

Size 15 needles

Large crochet hook (e.g., size K) for attaching fringe

Gauge: 15 sts = 6" in garter stitch on size 15 needles

Stitches/Terms: bind off (BO), cast on (CO), knit (K), garter stitch (knit every row), repeat (rep), stitch (st)

Note: Knit loosely throughout scarf to make it easier to pull the knobby bits through. Pull scarf lengthwise from time to time to "set" stitches.

When joining new ball of yarn, hold a 6" tail of old ball together with 6" tail of new ball and work over them for one row (thus weaving in tails as

you knit).

SCARF

Prepare fringe: Wind yarn around an 8" long strip of cardboard 30 times, then cut at one end. Set fringe aside.

With remaining yarn and size 15 needles, cast on 15 sts loosely.

Work in garter stitch (knit every row) until scarf is desired length, or until there is only enough yarn left to bind off. Bind off all stitches loosely.

To attach fringe: Using large crochet hook, attach one strand of fringe in each cast on and bound off stitch on ends of scarf as follows: insert

crochet hook into stitch, fold strand of fringe in half over hook, pull loop through fabric, then pull ends of strand through loop on hook, and tighten

knot. Trim fringe to desired length.

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
